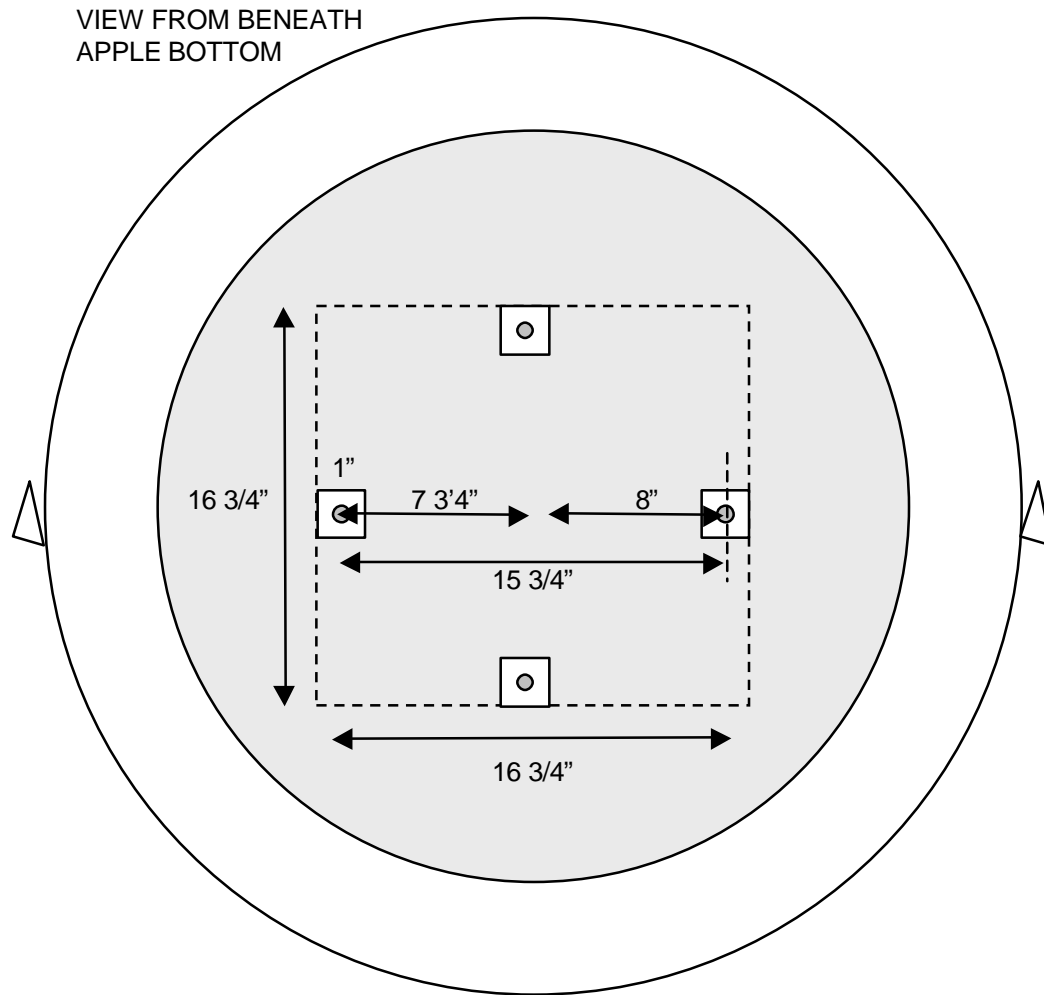


Big Apple - Base Bolts

There are 4 holes predrilled in the bottom of the apple for bolting to the concrete base.

There is a block of wood placed within the plastic poured into the apple bottom. The wood is thicker where the 4 predrilled holes are. The wood isn't visible from within the apple, so there must be about 1/2" more plastic poured into it.

The holes are 1 7/8" to 2" deep (1/4" wide holes). The drill holes hit plastic, so wood isn't more than 2" thick.

Distance between holes (from center of hole to center of hole) = 15 3/4"

Holes are aligned with Plexiglas bolts that connect the two apple halves.
